## **MAKE GIVING TO 3R A PART OF YOUR LENTEN JOURNEY**

**TOGETHER WE CAN "GIVE UP" SOME OF THE DEBT

**(REMODEL, RESTORATION AND RENEWAL)**

Here are the steps to participate in this journey:

- Beginning Sunday, February 4, you will find empty envelopes posted at the back of the church sanctuary.
- Each envelope will have a designated dollar amount written on it.
- Select an envelope that matches the amount you will "give up" during Lent
  - Ash Wednesday is February 14
  - Easter Sunday is April 1
- Donate that \$ amount by placing cash or check in it and returning to the church office. Or place in the offering plate Sunday mornings or Wednesday evenings during Lent.
- You may select more than one envelope
- You may need to also "give up" chocolate, special coffee or a meal out to balance your budget in order to do this. Or empty your loose change container and place in a heavy-duty envelope or bag and donate!
- 10 percent of the money from this fundraiser will be donated to the
- Lutheran Disaster Relief Fund (hurricanes, wildfires, flooding, etc.)

### **MATCHING FUND CHALLENGE!!!**

To be eligible for matching funds, donations must be made on or by Sunday, March 11!!

- For every \$2 donated, a matching donation will be given – up to a maximum matching donation of \$1000. In other words, if a total of \$2000 is donated during the first 4 weeks of Lent as part of this "envelope project," it will result in a total of \$3000.
- Updates on total amount donated will be made weekly, beginning Sunday, February 25.

The 3R Celebration Committee has set a goal of \$6000 to be raised as part of this special fundraiser during Lent. If goal is met, the Committee will provide special treats between services in April or May (date to be determined).
